NON-CORPORAL PUNISHMENT AGREEMENT

Corporal punishment is defined as the intentional causing of bodily pain by anyone of authority acting on behalf of the certified home. It includes but is not limited to the following:

1. Spanking, striking, shaking, poking, belting, or otherwise deliberately inflicting pain.
2. Pain caused by denial of food, rest, toilet permission, or other normal body activities.
3. Forcing an individual to assume a position of bodily strain, such as standing with hands extended or just standing in one position for undue length of time.
